Dear Students!

Our Faculty was always among the first to join European trends and accreditation requirements in veterinary education. The recently introduced 11th semester is fully in line with the above and must be regarded as an important development of the veterinary degree program in Budapest. Those, who were admitted to this 11-semester veterinary program should be aware of the implementation of a clinical rotation in the last semester as an integral part of their curriculum.

To clarify some pending issues, this Spring a meeting was held for the possibly widest student forum where the governors of the Faculty exchanged ideas with students, answered questions and listened to suggestions concerning the organisation of this period. A full consensus was reached that those currently in the 4th year may choose clinics that meet our curricular requirements also outside Hungary. The governors of the Faculty, however, stressed that this will be an extraordinary year and the following classes have to complete the 10-week period of the rotation at the Budapest Faculty Clinics if they opt for module 1 or 2 (see below!).
