

**Guideline**  
**State Veterinary Practice**  
11th semester

1. Veterinary administrative duties (official records, certificates, inventory, etc.).
2. Veterinary computerised networks, informatics; types, forms and contents of notifications.
3. Individual identifications, animal health certificates and passports, official records and registrations.
4. Animal movement and transport, fairs, exhibits and markets; administration and control.
5. Disposal of animal waste and carcasses.
6. Disinfection (disinfectants, means, supervision and control).
7. Organisation of eradication and control programs, eradication plans.
8. Control and prevention of notifiable diseases (vaccinations, monitoring, restrictions and other measures, e.g. obligatory treatment, killing, state compensation). Forms and contents of official decisions. Issuing three official decisions (e.g. observation of risky dogs, ordering official surveillance and control measures).
9. Veterinary services; veterinary and ethical rules, function of veterinary chamber.
10. Veterinary experts' and advisors' duties, official records on sample takings and inspections.

The student should complete a report in diary form about the practice, including the three official decisions and the expert's official record.
